CONSTITUTIONAL CHANGE:

SPECIAL RESOLUTION - adoption of changes to our Rules/Constitution as follows:

Clause 13.1.3

Each member of the Executive Committee shall, subject to these Rules, hold office for a term of two (2) years. One-half of the Committee shall retire at the conclusion of every second Annual General Meeting, but shall be eligible for re-election. In cases where the number of Committee members is odd, the number of members retiring shall be rounded up (to the nearest whole number) to ensure that no member's term ends outside the standard cycle.

Chapter IX – Dispute Resolution (replaces existing Chapter IX)

Clause 35 – Application

Any dispute arising between members, or between a member and the Society, relating to the affairs of the Society must be resolved in accordance with the dispute resolution process set out in Schedule 2 of the Incorporated Societies Act 2022.

Clause 36 – Principles

In applying the dispute resolution process under Schedule 2 of the Act, the Committee must ensure that:

All parties to a dispute are given a fair opportunity to be heard;

All parties are treated with respect, fairness, and without bias; and the process follows the principles of natural justice.
